



## Three FREE Community Recycling Days Planned in October for Residents and Businesses!

Simi Valley Education Foundation will hold three free community E-WASTE Recycling Days -- October 15, 16, and 17 -- geared towards reaching more people and businesses.

On Thursday and Friday, October 15 and 16, at the Elegant Gardens Nursery, 2046 Tierra Rejada Road in Moorpark, from 9:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m., individuals and businesses can drop off their e-waste. As a special incentive, the nursery will offer 20% off purchase of plants, one gallon to 36" box size with every drop off during those two days.

For those who can't make those days there will be another collection day on Saturday, October 17th from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Simi Valley Unified School District parking lot, located at 875 Cochran Street, Simi Valley -- just west of First Street. The cost is free and open to the public.

Trucks will be stationed during all three collection days to haul away unwanted computer monitors, television sets, plasma screens, laptops, keyboards, LCDs, cameras, stereos, cell phones, printers and other electronic items.

The Simi Valley Education Foundation wants to encourage those of you out there to bring your old electronics in so that they can be disposed of in a safe manner. By law, such products must now be 'e-recycled' -- and that means recycled properly and in ways that won't harm the environment. Be GREEN and help the Simi Valley Education Foundation earn money for every pound of E-waste recycled.
