



2013 Scholarship Endowment Program

Dear Applicant:

This Endowment Program is established to honor the wishes of the original donor to provide community college scholarships for students who cannot afford to fund their own education. These recipients are to be individuals who have shown to have a strong desire to succeed by educating themselves. The intent is that these scholarships will offer an opportunity or turning point in a young person's life that inspires them to go on to be an asset to our community.

The Simi Valley Educational Foundation (SVEF) will be awarding two-year community college scholarship this spring for students enrolling in a local community college in the fall of 2013. Two-year scholarships will be awarded to a total of three high school graduates selected from the four high schools in the Simi Valley who will be attending a local community college on a full time basis (minimum of 12 semester units). Each individual two-year scholarship will be for the sum of \$1,000 for the first year and after verification of the successful completion of at least 24 semester units, the student can apply for the second year allotment.

Scholarship Requirements:

- The recipients must have a financial need. These scholarships are intended to make it possible for the recipients to attend college when they would not have the financial resources to do so on their own.
- The recipients should be students who have tremendous potential, but may not have outstanding grades. The committee will be looking for individuals who have shown significant improvement during his/her high school career.
- Applicants must attach an official copy of his/her high school transcript for the first seven semesters of high school.
- Student must attend a local community college in the fall of 2011 and carry a full load of classes (minimum of 12 semester units).
- Must complete the application on the reverse side of this application form.
- Must include a personal essay providing the information requested on the reverse side of this application.
- One letter of recommendation.

Completed scholarship applications must reach your high school's Career Center Technician by Friday, May 3, 2013. Return your completed application with your personal essay and transcript to your high school Career Center/Counselor.
